ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Must be accepted to a college (2 or 4 year), art school, trade/military or technical school.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Complete the entire application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Sign the application to authorize a CHS counselor to access your student records.
- Obtain counselor's signature to confirm your eligibility, <u>before submitting application</u>.
- Type and attach the required student essays.
- Do not include confidential information (such as your address or social security number) with this scholarship application.

SUBMISSION

- Application must be completed by the student.
- Submit complete application in a sealed envelope marked: *PTSA Senior Scholarship*.
- Write your name and submission date on the envelope.
- Deliver application to Student Services office; place in PTSA Scholarship Awards box.
- Applications must be received no later than: <u>2:10 PM Wednesday, April 15th, 2020</u> (<u>This is the Wednesday just after Spring Break</u>)
