Policy 8020: Grading

- Teachers will following the provisions of policy 8020 when assessing students.
- September 30, 2021 Last day to WD from a SEM 1 H.S. course
- W (Withdrawal) code on transcript: if WD after 9/30 and did not transfer into another level of the same course.
- Level changes: only permitted until the mid-point of the course.

Student Technology Use in High School

All students are issued a school system laptop


