Target: To increase the numbers of graduating seniors from 22-23

School Climate

Target: To decrease the number of suspensions and disciplinary referrals from 22-23

Total # students (**Total students**): 1349

Overall # of suspensions (**# dispositions**): 32

Overall suspension rate (**rate**): 2.4%

School Strategies

1. Instructional staff engage in professional learning via reflective conversations, professional implementation period meetings, professional learning communities, and content meetings focused on the development of personalized learning supports.
2. Administrators and instructional staff perform walkthroughs and use look for tools with departments to improve instructional practice and reflect on equity in action
3. Leadership teams connect department plans to equity framework, implement the goals and monitor the progress
4. Staff implement the Beyond School Hours program to provide academic support and peer tutoring for all students
5. 9th Grade Team Develops Lessons implemented by NHS members and staff to foster community and reinforce school policies.
6. Implement PBIS and Code of conduct training to support staff in using restorative discipline techniques
